

ANGARI Foundation offers ocean webinars

Ocean Expert Exchange (OEE), launched in April, is a collaborative program between ANGARI Foundation and the University of Florida Thompson Earth Systems Institute's Scientist in Every Florida School initiative.

Open to audiences of all ages, OEE features free live interactive webinar events with experts in marine science and technology. While the program was developed in response to the distance learning needs of teachers and students during the COVID-19 pandemic, spring OEE webinars reached viewers from 21 states and 26 countries ranging in age from pre-K to gray.

Building on the popularity of the spring OEE events, program partners have assembled an exciting lineup for fall 2020. Highlighted topics include the development and application of cuttingedge underwater camera technologies to improve coral reef monitoring and advance ocean research, education and conservation and intriguing ecological interactions in sea turtle communities and mangrove ecosystems.
