Duration: Part-time (~10 hrs/week with check-ins 2x weekly)

Dates: Starting February 8, 2021 & ending June 8, 2021

Stipend: Unpaid; Foundation is willing to work with intern to secure university course credit as appropriate

About the Position: ANGARI Foundation works to promote scientists and their ongoing research, while increasing public engagement in science via sharing of science expeditions at sea and their findings with K-college classrooms and the public. These goals are primarily achieved through print, online and TV media, livestream, public outreach events, citizen science initiatives, classroom engagement and virtual reality film.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Assist with education efforts, including development of print and presentation materials
- Facilitate lesson design associated with Foundation's 360/VR films and support remote classroom adaptation
- Participate in virtual education and outreach events
