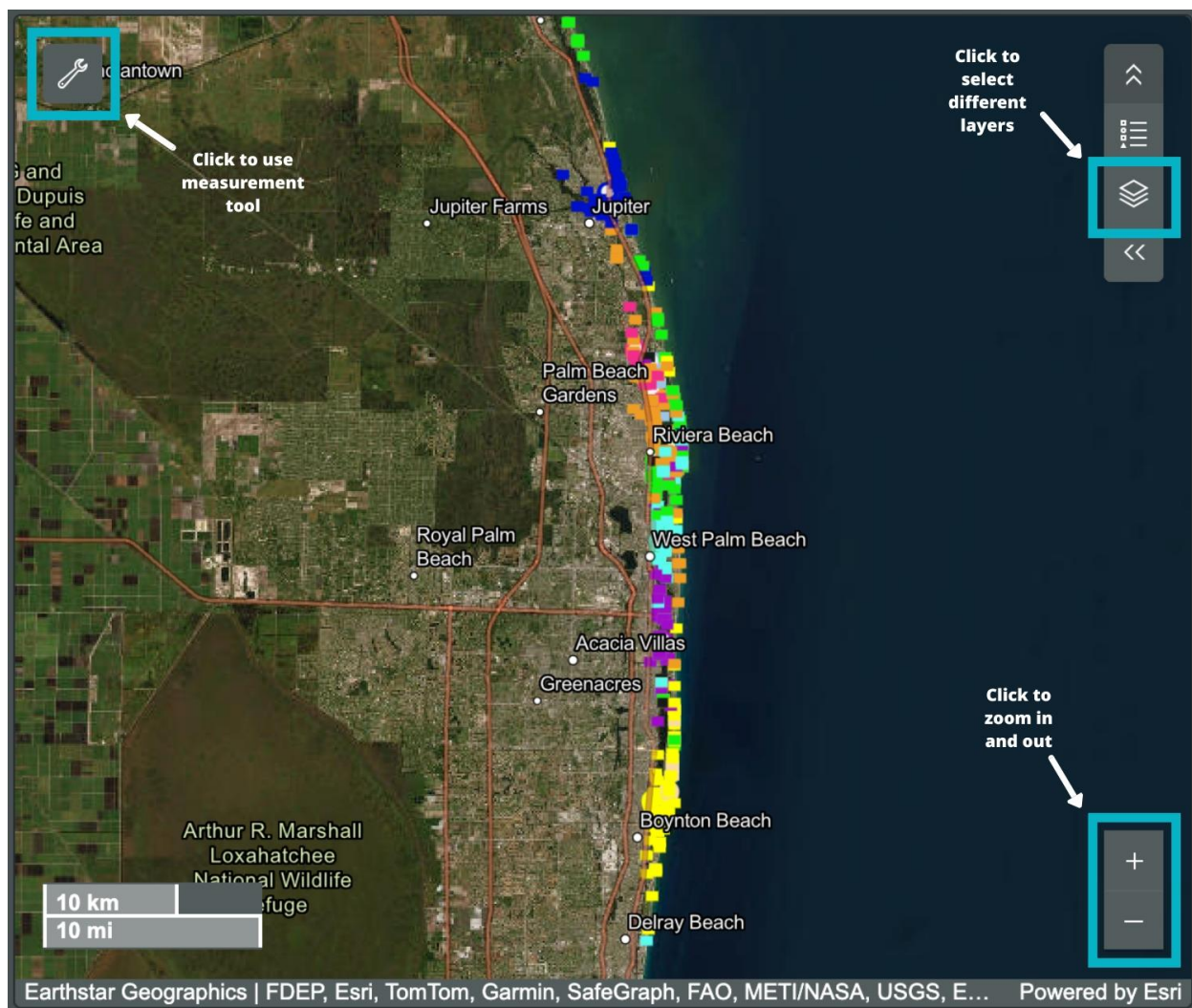




How to Navigate and Use the *Lagoon Drift* Interactive Dashboard and Map

This dashboard consists of several panels that display a variety of data. Any panel can be expanded to full screen by hovering over the top right corner of the panel and clicking the expand button . The operations of each panel are described in detail below for your reference.

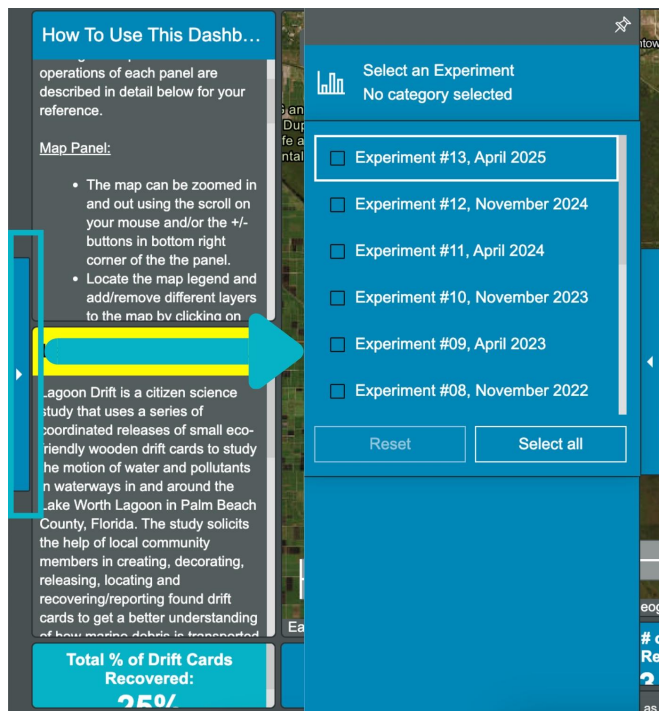
Map Panel



- The map can be zoomed in and out using the scroll on your mouse and/or the +/- buttons in the bottom right corner of the panel.
- Locate the map legend and add/remove different layers to the map by clicking on the icons located in the top right of the panel. Layers that can be chosen include:

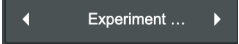
- Lake Worth Lagoon watershed border
- Canals and streams
- Shoreline characterization
- Areas of marine debris accumulation in Jupiter

- Click the wrench icon  in the top left-hand corner of the panel to use the measurement tools. To finish drawing your measurement double click on the map.
- Select specific experiment/release site data by clicking the blue arrow on the far left side of the dashboard to open the category selection options.



- Drift card reports  and release sites  are located on the map. Click on them to get additional details.

Experiment Weather and Tide Data Panel

- View data for each experiment by using the left and right arrows in this panel to toggle . Alternatively, click the experiment number at the bottom between the arrows to select an experiment from the menu.

Experiment Chart Panel

- View a different chart by using the left and right arrows in this panel to toggle . Alternatively, click the chart name at the bottom between the arrows to select an experiment from the menu.
- Hover over the chart to view specific data.
- Select the names in the bottom legend of the chart to toggle location data on and off.
